

Materials Needed

- **Worsted weight yarn**

You'll need two colors: Color A (contrast) and Main Color (MC). Feel free to get creative with your palette! Neutral tones create a modern look, while bright colors add a fun twist.

- **Crochet Hook:** Size 5 mm (U.S. H/8) or the size needed to obtain gauge.

- **Scissors**

- **Yarn Needle** (for weaving in ends)

Finished Measurements

Approx. **51 x 62 inches** (129.5 x 157.5 cm) – the perfect throw blanket for your couch, reading chair, or bed.

Gauge

13 stitches and **10 rows** = 4 inches (10 cm) in pattern.

Tip: Always check your gauge to ensure your blanket comes out the intended size.

Arrow Stitch Blanket Instructions

Foundation

- With **Color A**, chain **201**.

Row 1 (Right Side):

- 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd chain from the hook.
- 1 sc in each chain to the end.
- Chain 1, turn. **(200 stitches total)**

Row 2:

- 1 sc in each stitch across.
- Join Main Color (MC) at the end of the row.
- Chain 3, turn.

Row 3:

- Skip the first stitch.
- 1 double crochet (dc) in the next stitch.
- Skip the next 3 stitches.

- 1 treble crochet (tr) in the next stitch.
- Working **behind** the treble crochet just made, 1 dc in the first missed stitch, then 1 dc in each of the next 2 missed stitches.

Repeat pattern:

- *Skip next 3 stitches after the treble crochet.
- 1 tr in the next stitch.
- Working behind the tr, 1 dc in the first missed stitch, then 1 dc in each of the next 2 missed stitches.*

Repeat from * to the last 2 stitches.

- 1 dc in each of the last 2 stitches.
- Chain 3, turn.

Row 4:

- Skip the first stitch.
- 1 dc in the next dc.
- Skip next 3 dc.
- 1 tr in the next tr.
- Working **in front** of the tr just made, 1 dc in the first missed dc, then 1 dc in each of the next 2 missed dc.

Repeat pattern:

- *Skip next 3 dc after the tr.
- 1 tr in the next tr.
- Working in front of the tr, 1 dc in the first missed dc, then 1 dc in each of the next 2 missed dc.*

Repeat from * to the last 2 stitches.

- 1 dc in each of the last 2 stitches.
- Join Color A.
- Chain 1, turn.

Row 5:

- 1 sc in each stitch across.

- Chain 1, turn.

Pattern Repeat

Rows **2 to 5** form the pattern.

Continue in this sequence until your blanket measures approximately **50 inches** (127 cm), ending with a **Row 2** (single crochet row).

Do not chain at the end of the last row.

Fasten off.

Edging

- Join Main Color to any corner of the blanket.
- Work **1 row of single crochet (sc)** evenly around the entire outer edge, making **3 sc in each corner**.
- Join with a slip stitch (ss) to the first sc.

Final Round:

- Work **reverse single crochet (crab stitch)** around the entire blanket.
(This is worked from left to right instead of the usual right to left, creating a neat, corded edge.)
- Slip stitch to the first sc and fasten off.
